THE DEDICATION OF THE FIRST MARINE AVIATION MEMORIAL TOWER!

Don't miss this exciting three-day celebration as the nation's first Marine Aviation Memorial Tower is dedicated at MCAS New River, Jacksonville, NC. The 30 foot tower, designed and built by The Verdin Company of Cincinnati, OH, will stand in honor of all those Marines and sailors who have made the ultimate sacrifice.

Wednesday, May 26th, 2010 - The Pouring of the Bell



The Marine Aviation Memorial Tower will house a 24" diameter cast bronze bell that will be poured on-site by Verdin's *Bell Foundry on Wheels*, the only traveling bell foundry in the world. Come see this once in a lifetime event as the custom bell, a lasting symbol of casualty evacuation, is poured from the 2,200 degree furnace.

Thursday, May 27th, 2010 - The Unveiling of the Bell 3rd Annual Warrior Night Celebration



The 3rd Annual Warrior Night Celebration brings alive the heritage of Marine Corps aviation and allows generations of Marines, past and present, to gather and share their memories. The dinner is an informal Mess Night and will memorialize Marine aircrew, Marines and sailors who lost their lives during OIF/OEF.

Friday, May 28th, 2010 - Tower Dedication Day The Hanging of the Bell



On the final dedication day, the newly cast bell will be hung in the tower and will be rung for the first time in honor of the fallen. All in attendance will have an opportunity to ring the bell memorializing the sacrifices of all Marines past, present and future.
